Dear Praying Friends,

The last two months have not turned out as we expected. We send out this letter a little late because of the circumstances. As it turns out this will be a Christmas/New Year's letter instead of just a Christmas letter.

Our baby was due to be born November 25<sup>th</sup> and arrived nearly two weeks later. Cindy was scheduled for an induction December 8<sup>th</sup>. Our bundle of "Joy" came December 7<sup>th</sup> at 4:10 a.m. Emily Joy was 7lbs 11oz and 20 ½ inches long. She is a beautiful blessing. The miracle is not only in her birth but in the fact that for the first time Cindy did not need to have induced labor. It was a direct answer to prayer. We give God the glory and give thanks to all of you who prayed for her during this time.

This has been a transition time for us getting used to a new baby. I always try to help Cindy as much as I can, but times like this make me so much more thankful for the great help she is to me and to the work we are involved in. This has also been a good time for our girls to do more character building. They are a real help and have great attitudes.

In November I had several opportunities to share our burden. I had a blessed time in Pennsylvania as well as in Indiana. During my travels I was able to witness to a Muslim man. He did not get saved but I was able to exalt Jesus Christ as God's Son. I am always amazed at how God directs our paths to put us in specific places at specific times. December also afforded some preaching opportunities near home and that was a blessing.

I am pleased to report that the Lord has raised our support level to 57%. We continue to pray that God would give us more churches in which to share about the need among the Mennonites in Mexico. I still need to schedule 53 meetings to reach the goal I have set.

Please pray for Brother Wall who is laboring in Mexico and also for some of our friends that live there.

We pray God's richest blessing on you in the New Year. May you be blessed as you focus on the Lord and anticipate what He has for you in 2009.
