Dear Praying Friends,

In the last two months we attended several Missions Conferences and heard about many different works. I was motivated and encouraged. The presentations and the preaching services were excellent. Most of all, the Lord caused me to reflect on His goodness. My sins are forgiven, I live an abundant life and I get to serve Him. An opportunity availed itself for me to share this with a lady in a hotel we were staying at. She observed us coming and going during a Missions Conference and asked me how I could take my beautiful family to Mexico. This was an open door from the Lord to tell her exactly why. God is good.

Leaving Wyoming in early September, we witnessed God's artwork in the beautiful fall foliage of Ontario and the eastern states of North Carolina and Maryland. I heard a great message on building an altar and trusting God. The faith life is the most rewarding. How exciting to see God work. We desire to go to Mexico in fall of 2009. It is urgent. Brother Wall tells me that at times the Thursday night Mennonite Bible study almost fills his garage. We eagerly anticipate working with him in the area of Cuauhtemoc.

Our support level is now at 55% and many people are praying. We have visited 126 churches, and our goal is to visit 220. Please pray that God will direct us in this endeavor. I will travel to Pennsylvania and Indiana in November before our baby is due to arrive.

It has been good to be home for a short time. I have gone door knocking with home church folks for a couple of weeks and have been able to sit under my pastor's preaching. Cindy will be staying at home now until the New Year, as traveling is difficult for her. She is busy teaching our two oldest girls in school. They are doing well and enjoy it very much.

We thank those of you who have been praying, as well as those who have opened their homes to us in the last two months. Numerous cards and notes we received have been encouraging. It is good to know that we are being thought about. I pray daily for the good people in the churches of Canada and the United States. May God bring revival.

Please pray for Cindy's upcoming due date of November 25<sup>th</sup>, that she will not need an induced labour. This has been the case with each of our children. Please pray for health, quick healing and a miracle. May the Lord bless each of you.
