We also visited family in Alberta, which was a very special time. A proverb says, "Wisdom comes from years of keeping your mouth shut when you would have liked to have it open." We are thankful to have learned things from those of you we have spent time with.

It was a blessing to attend the National Pastors' Conference in Winkler. The preaching was excellent and it was good to see home folks as well as others we've met in the preceding months. Your friendship, encouragement and support mean a lot to us, and we pray for you frequently.

Please pray that God gives me wisdom in contacting a Mexican consulate to ask about requirements for ministering in Mexico. Our background enables my family and I to qualify as Mexican nationals and I believe this will be a help. We hope to schedule more meetings in Texas for 2008, and would like to enter Mexico for a time to make more informed plans.
