Joseph is not enjoying the traveling and we ask that you also pray for grace for our children. We thank God that our needs are being met and appreciate your prayers and friendship. It has been a real joy to get to know those of you we have recently met; we are praying for you too.

We would like to express holiday goodwill to each one, and may the Lord richly bless as you continue to serve.
